# Routine care for your out-of-area student

Kaiser Permanente now covers routine, continuing and follow-up care for out-of-area students,<sup>1</sup> who are legal dependents. Therefore, out-of-area students will now be covered for non-urgent medical needs, in addition to urgent and emergency care.

The Out-of-Area Student Benefit will cover up to:

- ▶ 5 office visits
- ▶ 5 diagnostic X-rays
- ▶ 5 prescription drug refills

Applicable copays/coinsurance apply.

If the provider bills us directly, you won't need to submit a claim. If the student pays out-of-pocket, submit the bill to us for reimbursement at:

## Who is eligible?

In order to be eligible for this benefit the following requirements must be met:

▶ The health plan subscriber must live in a Kaiser Permanente Colorado service area. If your group has a live-or-work provision that allows you to either live **or** work in the service area, and you are an HMO, DHMO, or HDHP member, your dependent is eligible.

- The dependent student must be registered full time-carrying at least 12 credits per term-at an accredited college, university, vocational, or boarding school. The school must be located outside any Kaiser Permanente service area.
- The dependent student must meet group eligibility requirements and be under the age limit specified in the service agreement.
- The student must be living outside the Colorado service area while at school. However, full-time students who temporarily live in another Kaiser Permanente service area may use the visiting member program and are NOT subject to the 90-day limit for visiting members.

#### How to enroll

Each eligible out-of-area student must be registered every year. To register, just fill out, sign, and mail an Out-of-Area Student Benefit certification form to:

#### **Exclusions and limitations**

The Out-of-Area Student Benefit does not cover the following:

#### **Emergency and urgent care**

Regardless of where an emergency occurs, this is always covered under your regular plan with applicable copays/coinsurance. Emergency room copays/coinsurance is waived if the member is admitted as an inpatient. If your out-of-area student is admitted to an out-of-plan hospital, contact us as soon as possible (preferrably within 24 hours) toll free at 1-800-632-9700 / TTY: 1-800-521-4874, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., weekdays, for assistance in coordinating care and reducing your risk of incurring non-covered inpatient charges.

#### Laboratory and other procedures

Charges for laboratory, procedures, and high cost X-rays (MRI/CT/PET) are not covered under this benefit.

#### Care with in home service area

Regular plan copayments/coinsurance applies to any care received within their home service area, and services must be obtained through Kaiser Permanente or its designated providers.

#### **Transplant services**

Transplant follow-up services are not covered under the Out-of-Area Student Benefit unless prior authorization is obtained from Kaiser Permanente.

Services obtained outside the United States Semesters abroad, semesters at sea, missionary work abroad, etc., are not covered.

### Important coverage information

If an out-of-area student member goes to school in another Kaiser Permanente service area, they may access Kaiser Permanente facilities/providers as they would in their home service area according to the specifics of their plan, as detailed in the applicable *Evidence of Coverage*.

- ▶ Out-of-Area Indemnity
- ▶ Point of Service (POS) plans
- ▶ Standard and Basic Small Group HMO plans
