# FAQ

## Q: What is the City of Atlanta Employee Wellness Center?

**A:** The Employee Wellness Center is a designated space for use by City of Atlanta employees. It is jointly managed and operated by Kaiser Permanente and HealthStat.

Kaiser Permanente members will see licensed Kaiser Permanente clinicians with access to their secure electronic health record for care.

## Q: What services will Kaiser Permanente offer at the Employee Wellness Center?

**A:** Kaiser Permanente will provide primary care services for City of Atlanta members.

- Abrasions, cuts, and stitches
- Acne, rashes, and skin problems
- Anemia
- Animal/Insect bites
- Arthritis
- Cellulitis
- Cold/Cough/Fever/Flu/Pneumonia
- Pink eye
- Depression/Anxiety
- Ulcers, Acid Reflux, Constipation, Diarrhea
- Dizziness/Nausea/Vomiting
- Ear ache and ear infections
- Athletes foot, Ringworm
- Gout
- Headache/Migraine
- Ingrown nail
- Muscle strain & sprain
- Physical exam
- Sinusitis
- Upper respiratory infections
- Urinary tract infection
- Viral Infections

## Q: Who can receive care at the wellness center?

**A:** Employees and pre-retirees can receive care at the center.

## Q: Will I be seen by my Kaiser Permanente primary care physician?

**A:** No. Kaiser Permanente members will be seen by highly-trained Nurse Practitioners who will have access to your electronic health record. These nurses will have access to your primary care physician if the need arises and your visit will be recorded in your electronic health record, which allows your physician to be kept up-to-date on your care.

## Q: Will I have to change my Kaiser Permanente primary care physician in order to be seen at the wellness center?

**A:** No. You should maintain your relationship with your primary care physician. The Employee Wellness Center is an alternative location for you to receive primary care. Your primary physician and home medical facility remain the same.

## Q: Will my co-pay change?

**A:** HMO Members will not be required to pay a co-pay for office visits and certain prescription drugs dispensed at the City of Atlanta Employee Wellness Center. HDHP members will have a \$30 co-pay. You will continue to pay applicable co-pays for services received in one of our Kaiser Permanente medical centers.

## Q: How can I schedule an appointment?

**A:** You can schedule your appointment by calling our Health Line at **404-546-4730** at any time. Follow up appointments can be made via phone or online at [kp.org](http://kp.org).

## Q: If a Kaiser Permanente provider is not available, can I see a HealthStat provider?

**A:** No. Kaiser Permanente members can only be seen by a Kaiser Permanente provider. If you need care during the hours a Kaiser Permanente provider is not available, we encourage you to make an appointment at the home office of your primary care physician. In the event of an urgent matter, visit the 24/7 Advanced Care Center at any of our three Comprehensive Medical Centers: TownPark, Southwood, or Gwinnett.

## Q: Can I complete any of my activities for the Wellness Program at the wellness center?

**A:** Yes. You can complete your biometric screening.

## Q: What disease management services are offered at the wellness center?

**A:** The following chronic disease management services are offered:

- Diabetes
- Asthma Treatment
- COPD
- Depression

- Hypertension (High Blood Pressure)
