You are currently enrolled in the Kaiser Permanente HMO plan. If you would like to keep your Kaiser Permanente health care coverage through **Conejo Valley Unified School District**, you (and your Medicare-eligible dependents) are required to enroll in the Kaiser Permanente Medicare health plan for Group Members.

When you join Senior Advantage, you will also enjoy the Silver & Fit membership, all you must do is register and select gym.

Please review the enclosed materials and return the election form in the enclosed, postage-paid envelope.

To be eligible, please follow the enrollment instructions:

- be post 65 and retired
- be enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B
- complete and return the Election Form before your requested effective date
- live within the Senior Advantage service network
